Rules & Regulations

Busseton Pride and its Committee, reserve the right to remove any entry from the parade, either prior to assembly, at assembly, or at any time during the parade. Any entry that does not conform to rules and regulations or any entrant who refuses to follow instructions of police or parade officials will be removed from the parade.

1. PARADE ENTRIES MUST FOLLOW THE DIRECTIONS OF PARADE OFFICIALS.
2. Busseton Pride retains the authority and ability to limit the number of large floats and vehicles.
3. Parade entries may not be shared – one group/organization per entry.
4. Distributing merchandise, gifts, candy, literature or other materials are allowed, but we request you respect that this event is family friendly and that no inappropriate material is to be handed out i.e condoms to children.
5. Distributing literature that conflicts with Busseton Pride is not permitted.
6. ALL vehicles must be road-worthy and may be subject to make and model restrictions.
7. City noise ordinances require all units be no louder than 75 decibels. No continuous honking, bells, whistles, sirens or air horns permitted. Units may be asked to reduce volume of PA systems.
8. Parade participants must keep pace with the line of march. No counter-marching, stopping or any other manoeuvre contrary to the forward progress of the parade is allowed.
9. Alcoholic beverages and other controlled substances are forbidden on any float, in any vehicle, or on the person of any parade participant. Participants who consume alcohol prior

to parade start are not permitted to enter the line of march, and people who use alcohol or other controlled substances during the parade will be removed

10. Riders and drivers are to drive to the current road conditions and take into account: weather, the narrow road space and be aware that there are no barriers between themselves and the spectators.

LIABILITY RELEASE AND RULES AGREEMENT

The entry agrees to indemnify, hold harmless and defend against any action against Busselton Pride, City of Busselton, all sponsoring organizations and their officers, directors, employees and agents from and against all liabilities whatsoever arising out of its participation in the Busselton Pride Parade. Entrant agrees to comply with the rules of the Busselton Pride Parade as listed in this form or additional rules deemed necessary for the safe conduct of the Busselton Pride Parade and related activities. Failure to comply may cause denial of entry on parade day or jeopardise future parade participation.
